### 1. Christ Jesus Came to Save Sinners (1 Tim 1:15)\*

- A. Why does Paul say that he is the 'foremost of all' sinners?  
see: 1 Tim 1:13; Acts 9:1-2; compare: Rom. 7:14-25
- B. How does Paul understand his salvation as it relates to evangelism?  
see: 1 Tim 1:16; compare: 1 Cor. 6:11
- C. How does this relate to Jesus' ministry and the early church?  
see: Luke 4:39; 19:10; John 6:38-40; Acts 2:22-24, 36-42
- D. How should this trustworthy statement effect the way that I live my life?  
see: Matt 28:19-20; 1 Pet. 3:15-16

### 2. It is Good to Desire to Serve as an Elder (1 Tim 3:1)

- A. How should we understand this along side of James' warning?  
see: Ja. 3:1; compare: 1 Pet. 5:1-4
- B. How should this trustworthy statement effect the way that I live my life?  
see: 1 Cor. 16:15, 16; Heb. 13:7, 17

### 3. Discipline for Godliness is Profitable (1 Tim 4:8, 9)\*

- A. What should be our motivation in being disciplined for godliness?  
see: 1 Tim. 4:10; 1 Jn. 2:28-29; 3:3
- B. How ought we to think about having discipline with our bodies?  
see: 1 Cor. 9:24-27
- C. How should this trustworthy statement effect the way that I live my life?  
see: 1 Tim. 4:4-7

### 4. Jesus Remains Faithful (2 Tim 2:11)

- A. How is this related to calls for the Christian to persevere and endure?  
compare: Heb. 12:1-2; 1 Pet. 2:21-25; 3:17;
- B. How should this trustworthy statement effect the way that I live my life?  
see: Rom 8:35-39; Phil. 1:6; Ti. 1:2

### 5. Engage in Good Deeds (Titus 3:8)

- A. How are good works related to salvation?  
see: Eph. 2:10; compare: Lk. 3:8; Jn. 15:1-11; Ja. 2:18-26;
- B. How ought the Christian be equipped and evaluate good works?  
see: 2 Tim. 3:16-17; compare: Col. 3:16-17 and Eph. 5:18-19
- C. How should this trustworthy statement effect the way that I live my life?  
see: Eph. 2:10; compare: Ti. 2:11-14
